

SCHOOL UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

JUNIOR UNIFORM (Years 9 to 11)

GIRLS:

- Charcoal LBC skirt (knee length) or trousers
- White LBC blouse
- Black woollen LBC jersey with horizontal stripe
- Lace up or slip on shoes must have a closed heel. They are to be plain black, with an all leather surface (no rubber toe sections). No boots, sports shoes (or shoes with logos) sneakers or canvas shoes. Plain black sandals (no jandals) may be worn in summer without socks
- Shoes are to be worn with plain black or flesh coloured stockings/tights, plain black ankle socks or black knee length socks

BOYS:

- Charcoal LBC shorts or trousers
- Grey LBC shirt
- Black woollen LBC jersey with horizontal stripe
- Long black LBC socks with shorts. Plain black ankle socks with trousers
- Lace up or slip on shoes must have a closed heel. They are to be plain black, with an all leather surface (no rubber toe sections). No boots, sports shoes (or shoes with logos) sneakers or canvas shoes. Plain black sandals (no jandals) may be worn in summer without socks

SENIOR UNIFORM (Years 12 & 13)

GIRLS:

- Charcoal LBC skirt (knee length) or trousers
- Black & white pinstriped LBC blouse
- Black woollen LBC jersey with vertical stripe
- Tie, if worn, is to be knotted at the collar
- Shoes, sandals, stockings/tights and socks are the same as for Junior Girls above

BOYS:

- Charcoal LBC shorts or trousers
- Black and white pinstriped LBC shirt. May be worn un-tucked and buttoned from the second button from the top
- Black woollen LBC jersey with vertical stripe
- Tie to be knotted at the collar and worn only with long trousers and with shirt tucked in
- Shoes, sandals and socks are the same as for Junior Boys above

OPTIONAL

- Plain Black cap – absolutely no motifs.
- Plain white collarless short sleeve t/shirt may be worn under the uniform shirt. It may be visible at the neck only.
- School jacket.
- Plain black or white scarf.
- Blazer and Tie for Years 12 & 13 students.
- School jerseys and coats should be used over the top of shirts and blouses for extra warmth. A visible, long sleeved shirt under a blouse or shirt is not a substitute for a jersey, nor is it within our expectations.
- School hoodies are available as part of the sporting uniform but are not to be worn as part of the school uniform.

SPORTS UNIFORM

Students must wear the sports uniform at school sporting occasions when representing Long Bay College. These items should not be worn at any time with the main school uniform.

JEWELLERY, MAKEUP AND TATTOOS

- Any request to wear non-regulation items must be made, in writing, to the Year Level Deputy Principal
- Only one small (no more than 3mm) plain stud or small plain hoops (no more than 10mm) may be worn in each ear lobe
- No other jewellery is permitted (including face or body piercing ornamentation)
- Makeup, including nail polish, is not to be worn
- Tattoos must be covered and not visible when wearing school uniform

HAIR

- Moderate styles and 'natural' colours (at the discretion of the Year Level Deputy Principal)
- Students are to be clean shaven while attending College
- There are occasions when hair must be tied back for safety reasons

SCHOOL BAGS

- No advertising other than the maker's name
- No graffiti
