- NCEA Digital Exams important information: Are you completing a digital exam (rather than paper-based)? Check your NZQA exam admission slip as soon as possible. There are some important steps that need to be completed well before the day of the digital exam.

1). Check your digital login for your exam is working by doing a test. Testing must be completed at least two working days prior to the day of the exam.
