- JUNIOR MATHEMATICS COMPETITION All year 9, 10 and 11 students are invited to participate in the Junior Mathematics Competition run by the University of Otago. The competition is a **one hour multiple choice and short answer online exam** with an emphasis on problem solving.
  - The competition will be **run at school on Wednesday, April 14**. **Entry is \$5 per learner** which is to be paid at the finance office by Monday 12 April. The top 15% of participants will then be invited to take part in the **second round which is a paper exam on Wednesday, May 12**. At each year level in the second round there will be a first prize of \$300, a second prize of \$250, a third prize of \$200, and 27 outstanding awards of \$50. Certificates are also awarded for Top 100 and Top 200 placings. 
