2. Principal's Report

2.1 Principal's Report

Topics in the Principal's Report include: Principal's Comments; Appointments and Resignations; Overnight Trip Requests; Context and Information: Roll Data, Health & Safety, Learning Support, Sports, Performing Arts, Medical and Wellbeing Centre. Strategic and Annual Planning: Faculty Action Plan Summaries, Stand-down Data. Personnel: Staff Leave, New Positions Advertised, Celebrations and Events.

The Board raised some questions about the Wellbeing Report and whether there was need for additional resources. Mr Healey will get clarification around the comment in the report that we do not have sufficient funding for Māori and Pacifica mentoring programmes. The Health Centre is looking to get an additional defibrillator. A question was raised whether we have external mentors working with our Māori and Pacifica students – we do not currently.

Mr Healey explained the stand-down and suspension process to the Board. Incidents are brought to him by a Deputy Principal. The student's family are invited in to unpack what has happened. If it is serious enough the student would be suspended and it would go to the Board for a disciplinary meeting, otherwise it would be a stand-down. Stand-downs can be 1-5 days in any given term, but no more than 10 days in a year. When a student returns from a stand-down or suspension the restorative process starts. The student is on daily report to check on attendance, attitude and behaviour.

There was discussion around what the reasons could be for the drop in roll data from year 11 in 2021 to year 12 in 2022. Comments were that Covid has had an impact on engagement and has also created lots of job opportunities.
